



Community College of Philadelphia has signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification of Agreement and has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004 (a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

**What was the total amount of funding Community College of Philadelphia Received?**

The total amount of Institutional Funds awarded from the Department of Education in HEERF Funding is \$113,797,174.

**What is the total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants Community College of Philadelphia paid?**

Community College of Philadelphia paid a total of \$110,692.82 to students during the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter.

**What is the total amount of students Community College of Philadelphia estimates as eligible for Cares Act Funding?**

Community College of Philadelphia estimated that there were 3,715 credit students with 30 or more earned credits and 359 noncredit students that were eligible based on the Spring 2023 semester enrollment.

**What is the total amount of students who received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant at Community College of Philadelphia College in Cares Act Funding?**

There are 1,004 students who received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant during the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter.

**What method did Community College of Philadelphia use to distribute Cares Act Funding?**

During the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter, credit students enrolled in classes for the Spring 2023 term with at least 30 earned credits towards their degree program and non-credit students enrolled in Non-Degree Programs were provided with an opportunity to apply for emergency grant funding.

The awards were issued according to the distribution below to students with completed applications on file and was intended as an emergency financial aid grant for any component of the cost of attendance or emergency costs due to coronavirus, such as: tuition; food; housing; health care (including mental); and childcare.

- \$165 for credit students who were full-time and received a Pell Grant award
- \$100 for credit students who were less than full-time and received a Pell Grant award
- \$126 for credit students who were full-time and did not receive a Pell Grant award
- \$80 for credit students who were less than full-time and did not receive a Pell Grant award
- \$80 for noncredit students
