BENEFITS SCREENING – Quick screening will provide you with information as to whether you qualify for federal/state benefits, such as food and nutrition programs (SNAP, WIC), health insurance (CHIP, Medicaid), cash, utilities, and transportation assistance. In addition, Single Stop staff can help you apply and troubleshoot if any issues arise.

TAX PREPARATION – From January through April 15, you can meet with a certified tax preparer and have your taxes filed for free. Tax preparers will determine and help you maximize your tax credits and refund.

HEALTH CARE ENROLLMENT – Learn about different health care insurance options and get assistance with enrolling and/or renewing your coverage.

FINANCIAL EDUCATION – Financial advisors will help you establish and achieve your financial goals. You can receive guidance with budgeting, banking, credit counseling, and debt management.

LEGAL COUNSELING – On-site attorneys will provide guidance with public benefits, housing, utilities, employment, and immigration issues.

REFERRAL SERVICES – Single Stop staff will assess your needs and make referrals to connect you with additional on-campus and external services and resources.
