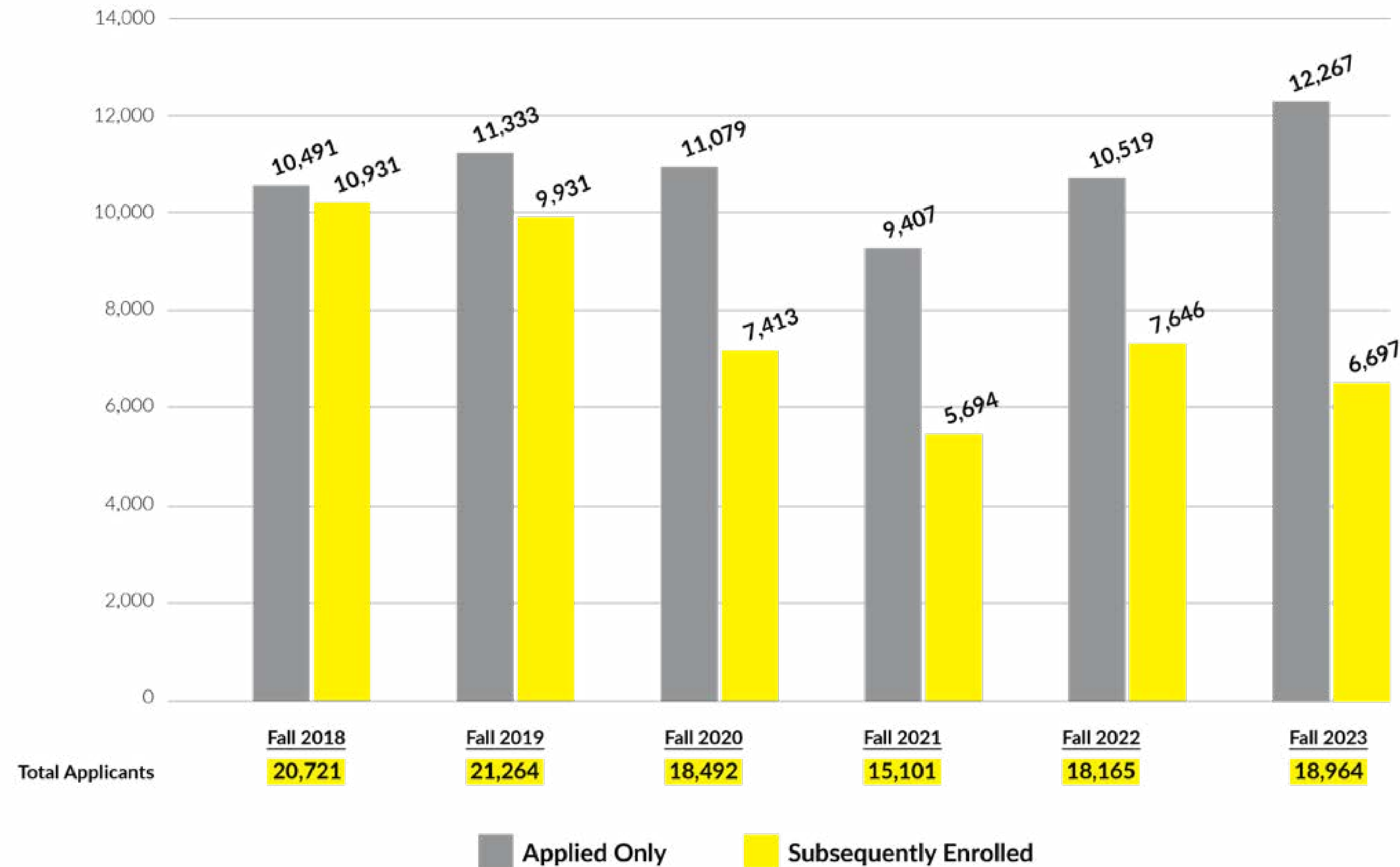

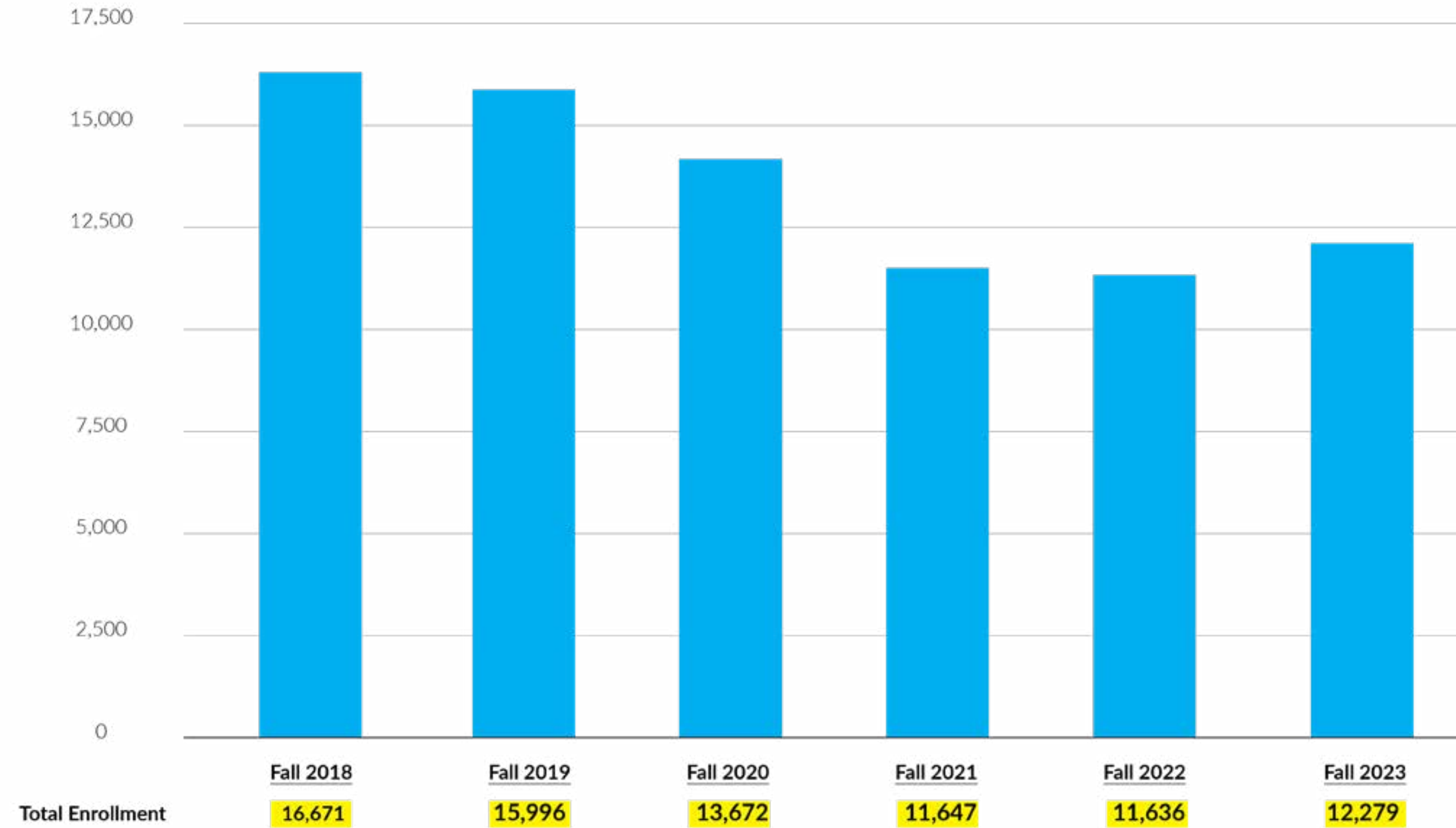

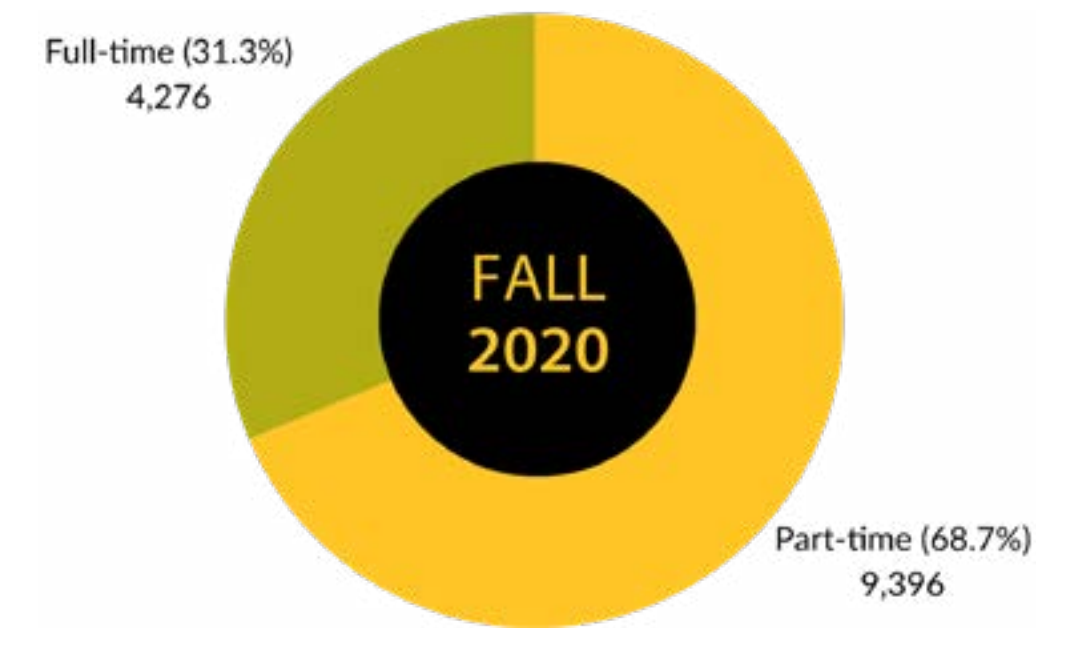

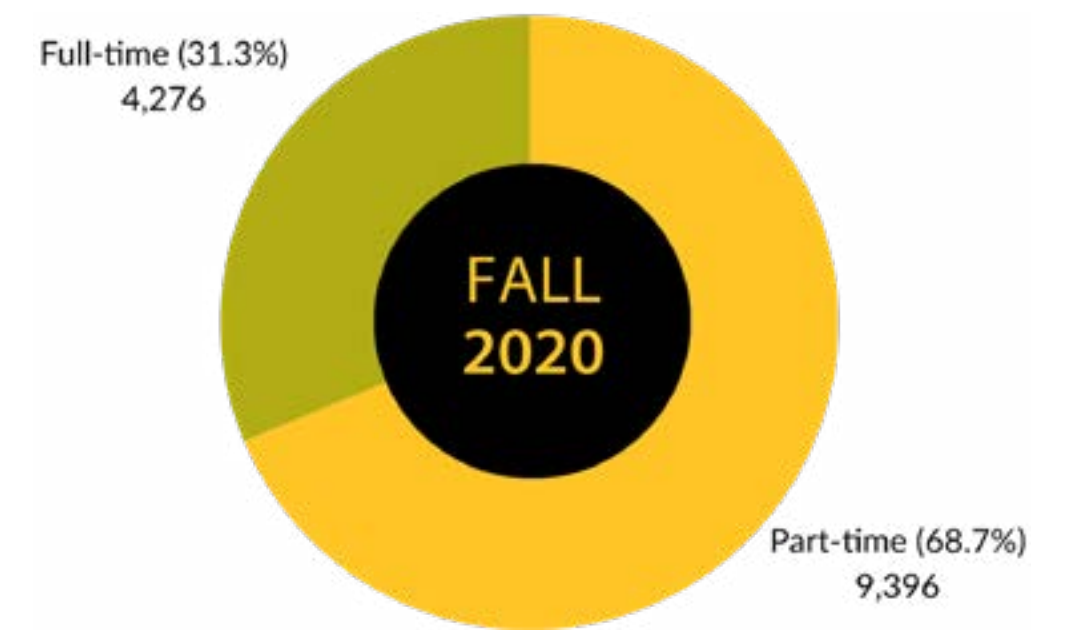

3.1: GRADUATION RATES (2016 – 2021)

The table below displays various success metrics as reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). Metrics reported to IPEDs are based on cohorts of first-time, full-time College students who begin at the College in a fall semester.

For graduation and transfer rates, the cohort year is three years behind the reporting year. For example, the 18% graduation rate reported in 2021 is for the 2018 cohort. The data presented here is accurate as of Nov. 29, 2023.

3.2.1: DEGREES BY PROGRAM (2018 - 2023)

The first two rows in the table below show the total number of duplicated degrees and unduplicated graduates. A student can earn more than one credential within a graduation year (July 1 - June 30). Thus, the duplicated degrees count reflects the total number of credentials.

The unduplicated graduate count, conversely, only counts a student once per graduate year, even if they earned more than one credential. The program-level rows show the unduplicated graduates per degree program. The programs are listed in the order of when they became listed at the College, then by the first year in which a degree was conferred. The data presented here is accurate as of Nov. 29, 2023.

4.1: HUMAN RESOURCES: STAFF DEMOGRAPHICS (2016 – 2021)

The table below displays the basic demographic information of College employees separated as the data is reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). “Non-instructional staff” includes 12-month faculty such as librarians, counselors, advisors, and Learning Lab faculty.

FTE stands for “full-time equivalent” and converts part-time staff into measurements comparable to full-time staff; for example, a full-time employee equals 1 FTE whereas a half-time employee would equal 0.5 FTE. The data presented here is accurate as of Nov. 29, 2023.
