

International Student Services Placement Test Information

Before being issued immigration documents or enrolling in classes, all students must satisfy placement. The placement test measures skills in reading, writing, listening, speaking and math to help determine your level of courses.

If you place at an ESL level, the College provides ESL courses that may be taken along with your academic courses. If you place below the minimum ESL level, you will *not* be able to enroll in courses and should meet with a member of ISS.

Overseas students will take a remote live-proctor test. Students inside the US will be able to choose to test on-campus (COVID protocol dependent) or with a remote live-proctor. The test is free of charge.

TEST WAIVERS

Some students may qualify for either a full or partial test waiver. How to qualify:

- Already have a college degree from an accredited US college
- Passed college-level English composition and/or mathematics courses with a C or better from an accredited US college
- US High School GPA minimums (details: <https://ccp.edu/getting-started/what-are-placement-tests>)
- Received the minimum scores on one or more of the following tests within the last 2 years:
 - IELTS: 6.0 overall AND 6.0 in Writing
 - TOEFL: 77 overall AND 20 in Writing
 - SAT English: 560 SAT Math: 510
 - ACT English: 21 ACT Math: 21

If you meet one of the above requirements, please send the official transcript or test score(s) by email to international@ccp.edu, or upload them to the application portal. You will then be notified if you are waived from either the English and/or math portion of the placement test and given further instructions regarding your next steps

REQUESTING A PLACEMENT TEST

The Assessment Center will then be in contact with you with next steps to schedule your ACCUPLACER placement test. It is important that you are prepared to test one you are issued a voucher, as they have an expiration date. **Be sure to test before your voucher expires.**

NOTE: Do **NOT** request a test by clicking the link in the MyCCP Portal (Student Tab>Enrollment Services>Schedule a Placement Test); International Students cannot schedule their test this way and it will cause delays in processing. Please **ONLY** request a test using the link above after you have completed an online application and have a Student ID Number.
